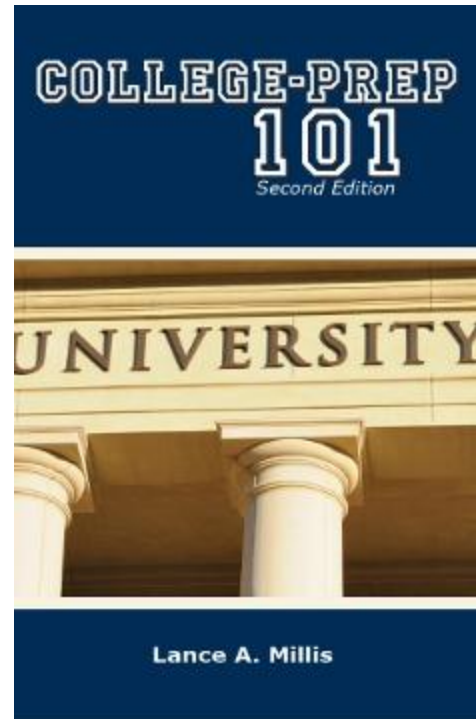

Parents will be thrilled with the fact that most of the book is written directly to the student, but there is still plenty for parents, with their own checklist, chapter, and numerous points throughout.
